Special Presentation by Dr. Amanda Grenier: Precarity in Later Life? Balancing Housing and 'Home'



Abstract: Healthy and successful aging in the community and at home dominates the landscape of policy frameworks and community-based programming. Yet, such ideals can be difficult to achieve for seniors with life course trajectories related to poverty, marginalization or exclusion. We must begin to speak about 'home' and housing, as well as the conditions that must be in place to mitigate inequality in late life and ensure that all older people have access to 'aging well'.
